HONORING A LOCAL HERO

This month we are honoring a local hero, Dave Aronberg. Dave was elected State Attorney for the 15th Judicial Circuit in November 2012 and re-elected without opposition in 2016 and 2020. He is a former Assistant Attorney General. White

House Fellow and Florida Senator.
As State Attorney, Aronberg leads a team of 115 prosecutors and 180 professional staff in five offices throughout Palm Beach County. Aronberg's leadership has led to high state rankings in conviction rates for both felonies and misdemeanors, a decrease in the number of juveniles direct filed into adult court, and a greatly improved working relationship with local, state and federal law enforcement agencies.

In 2016, he created a Sober Homes Task Force that has made more than 120 arrests for patient brokering and insurance fraud in the rehab industry, and has led to several new Florida laws and regulations that have become the model for other states. Aronberg's efforts also convinced Google to restrict advertisements and improve screening for addiction treatment. The crackdown in rogue sober homes and corrupted drug treatment contributed to a 14% decrease in opioid-caused deaths in Palm Beach County in 2021, compared to the previous year.

Aronberg frequently appears on national television as a legal commentator. He has a passion to speak out on criminal justice issues, adding transparency to our legal system.



National Transportation Safety Board now investigating Belle Glade crash that killed 9 people

Investigators with the National Transportation Safety Board are now in Palm Beach County as part of the team trying to figure out what caused a crash in Belle Glade Monday night that killed nine people.

"Our mission is to understand not just what happened but why it happened," said NTSB Board Member Alvin Brown.

The Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office said a Ford Explorer carrying ten people crashed through a guardrail on Hatton Highway around 7:30 Monday night and flipped into a canal.

Nine people in the SUV were killed, including six children under the age of 15.

"She was my heart, and she was my soul, and she was my baby," Lloyd Hall said of his daughter, 30-year-old Leiana Hall. Leiana was one of the victims in the crash.

"I miss her so much," Lloyd said. "Words can't even explain how much I miss that girl."

Lloyd also lost two grandsons in the crash, 8-year-old Imani Hall and 14-year-old Michael Hall, Jr. Michael was in the United States for the first time from Jamaica.

"My son was a very calm and peaceful, loving person," said his father, Michael Hall, Sr. "He loved his family. He loved his mom." Many of the victims' family members have openly questioned the safety of the rental car they were driving in. "Whatever issue was there, I want to know that it was taken care of and sorted out," Michael said.


Brown said it's too early to say exactly what caused the crash. He did say they will be examining the vehicle along with the

conditions of the road and any potential human factor that may have contributed to the death of nine people.

"The tragic thing more than anything is the loss of life," Brown said. "It's so important for us to be here." Brown said NTSB would provide periodic updates on its investigation and expected a preliminary report to be available in about a month.
