BILL TO INCREASE SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY LIMITS IS ON TO THE SENATE FLOOR

A Senate panel agreed Thursday to send a revised sovereign immunity reform proposal to the floor, and an uncertain fate. The Senate Appropriations Committee voted 15-0 to approve **SB 472** by Sen. Jason Brodeur, R-Lake Mary.

The measure would double the per person and per incident caps on claims against government entities of \$200,000 and \$300,000 respectively, beyond which, an injured plaintiff is required to seek legislative approval through a "claims bill."

In addition to doubling the caps to \$400,000 and \$600,000 respectively, the bill would authorize local governments to settle for higher amounts without legislative approval. Insurance companies would be prohibited from tying payments to the success of a claims bill.
